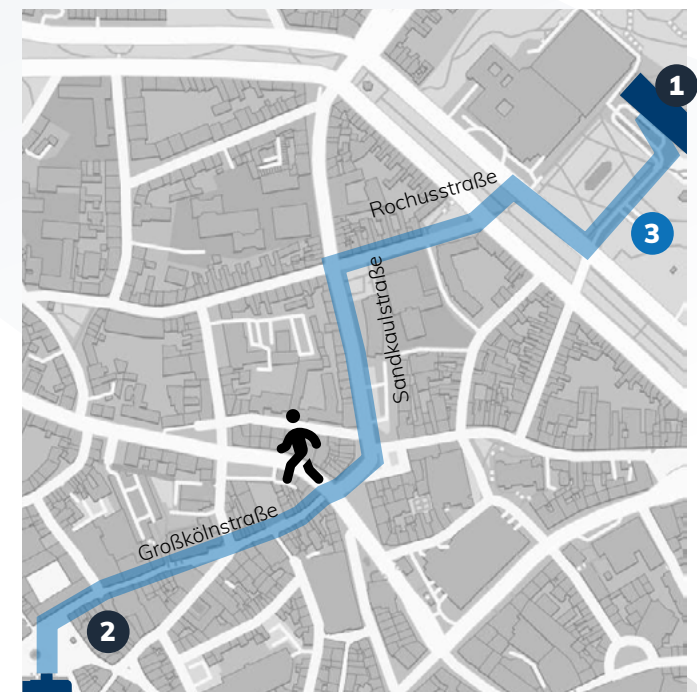

Vehicle Sound Development at Audi

Vehicle sound has evolved from a mechanical byproduct into a key element of brand identity and customer experience. At Audi, sound development combines engineering, psychoacoustics, and design to create distinctive acoustic signatures for conventional and electrified vehicles. Sound supports brand values such as sportiness, refinement, and technological progress. While combustion engines remain important, downsizing and efficiency measures often reduce their emotional character, increasing the need for targeted acoustic design. Electric vehicles require new sound concepts, including regulatory functions such as AVAS. Audi therefore develops both refined combustion-engine soundscapes and synthetic electric sounds to ensure a consistent brand experience. Supported by an in-house software tool, engineers and designers can prototype, evaluate, and refine vehicle sounds, enabling efficient development of acoustic experiences.

Design and Characterization of Vibro-acoustic (Meta-)Materials for Passive Noise Control

Design of acoustic and vibroacoustic metamaterials has become a fashionable trend in research over the recent two decades. There have been a number of applications of these metamaterials for industrial applications at the Chair of Vibroacoustics of Vehicles and Machines at the Technical University of Munich. The talk will revisit a number of these applications and further discuss new methodologies to identify and characterize acoustic and vibroacoustic materials in both, controlled laboratory environments and in situ.

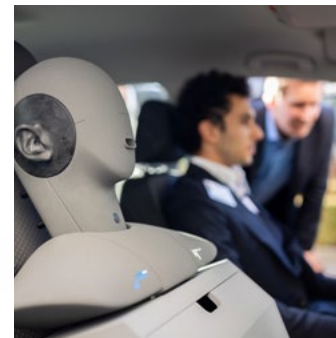

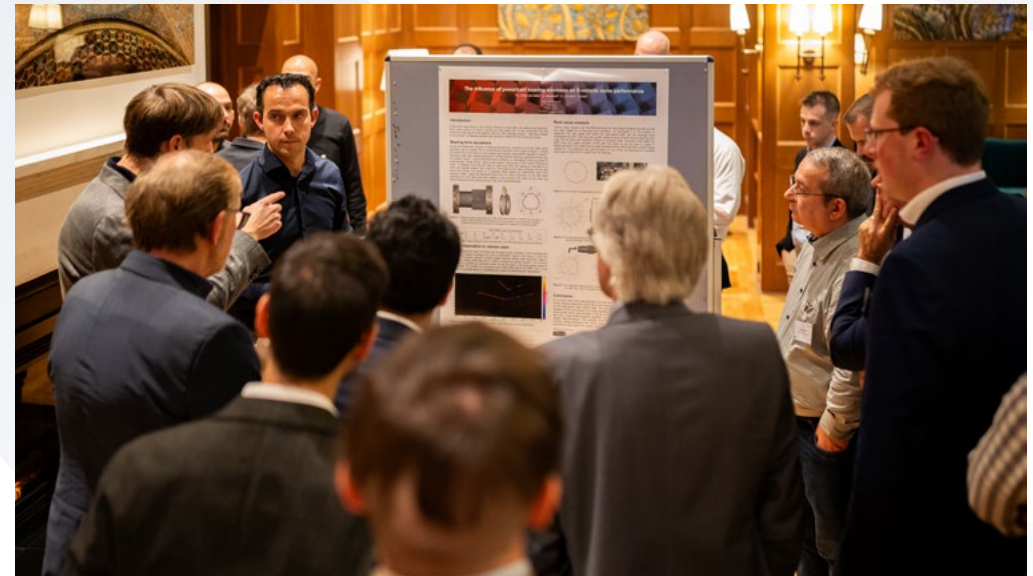
